### 7.2.5 Outputs

- 900+ disabled and disadvantaged members of the community including the 1,076 drop in members who in year 2009/09 directly sought money advice, including fuel billing, debt, tax credit, benefit, rent and council tax arrears.
- By providing one to one guidance and support, to assist, then empower, the member to deal with the initial/and ongoing money crisis.
- By encouraging the member through follow up, to agree to address the bigger issue of money management by attending budget planning and follow up sessions'

### 7.2.6 Outcomes

- 150 members will receive debt advice and follow up, leading to empowerment to better management of their financial instability.
- 75 members who will sign up to a money management plan (MAP) including setting up a savings account with The Craigmillar Credit Union.
- 150 members who will receive fuel billing advice enabling them to set up payment plans and reduce stress and marginalisation.
- £500,000 will be generated in economic capital to be spent within the local community.
