This will include encouraging volunteers to make use of open spaces by developing and participating in the CAN 'Breathing Space' allotment.

- Part two of the project is for a Community Information Point for the Portobello / Craigmillar ward. This project has been developed by the Craigmillar Partnership Health Inequalities sub-group and involves a partnership between the Neighbourhood Partnership, the South East LHP, local voluntary and community organisations by; collating information about local services, activities and opportunities available to residents (separately funded) and to use volunteers to help residents make best use of this information. CAN will manage and support this project within the Craigmillar centre with future expansion to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary and other medical centres is planned.
